Grade 1

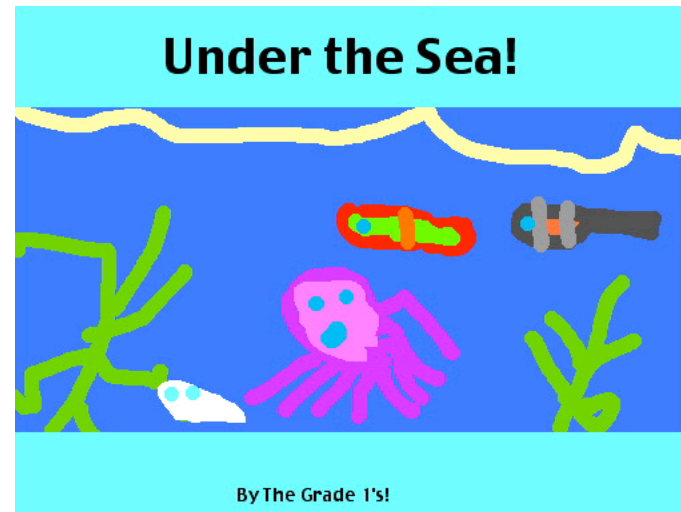
Students can do research in either the lab or classroom. They come to the lab with their final sentence, and then make a picture with HYPERSTUDIO.

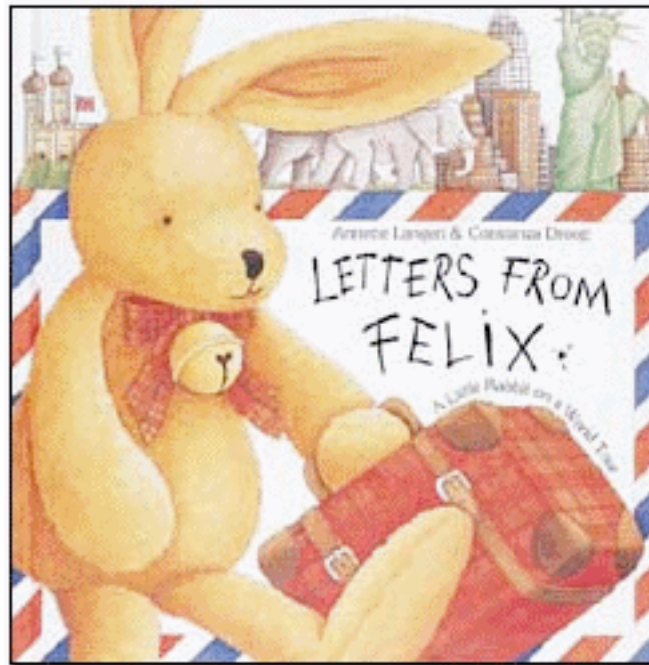

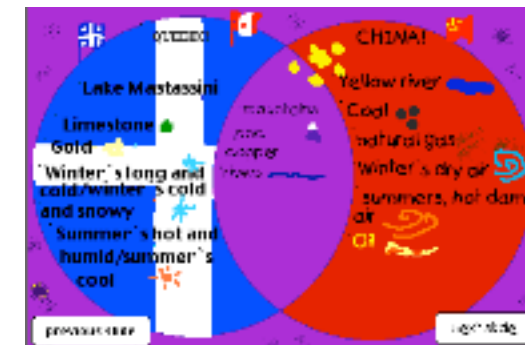
