- Not just a site full of links
- Use games to promote skill development in literacy
- Provide English & French templates to present reading recommendations, contests, events
- Offer a space for children to connect with peers and foster social development
- Promote ties to in-branch programming, seasonal activities and highlight what the library has to offer by drawing on events database
- Protect the privacy of children using the site

Promoting Literacy

- Wide variance in skills promoted by the library
 - Birth to Five
 - Developing crucial pre-literacy skills
 - Learning the pre-cursors to reading
 - Six & Up
 - Promoting growing reading skills
 - Sharing a love for books and other materials
- Two sub-sites or areas of the website had to be developed

Design Criteria

- Fully bilingual
- Flash elements are acceptable, but not special plugins, Active –X etc.
- Utilize OPL's mascot, BOPL the "fire reading dragon" to tie two sections together

Preschool Site – ALA's Every Child Ready to Read

- Six skills to promote
 - Vocabulary: Knowing the names of things
 - Print Motivation: Building interest & enjoyment of books
 - Print Awareness: Learning the basic rules of language
 - Narrative Skills: Be able to understand & tell stories
 - Letter Knowledge: Letter have names and are different – specific sounds go with specific letters
 - Phonological Awareness: Ability to hear & manipulate the smaller sound in words

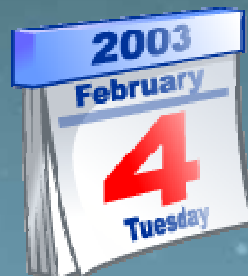

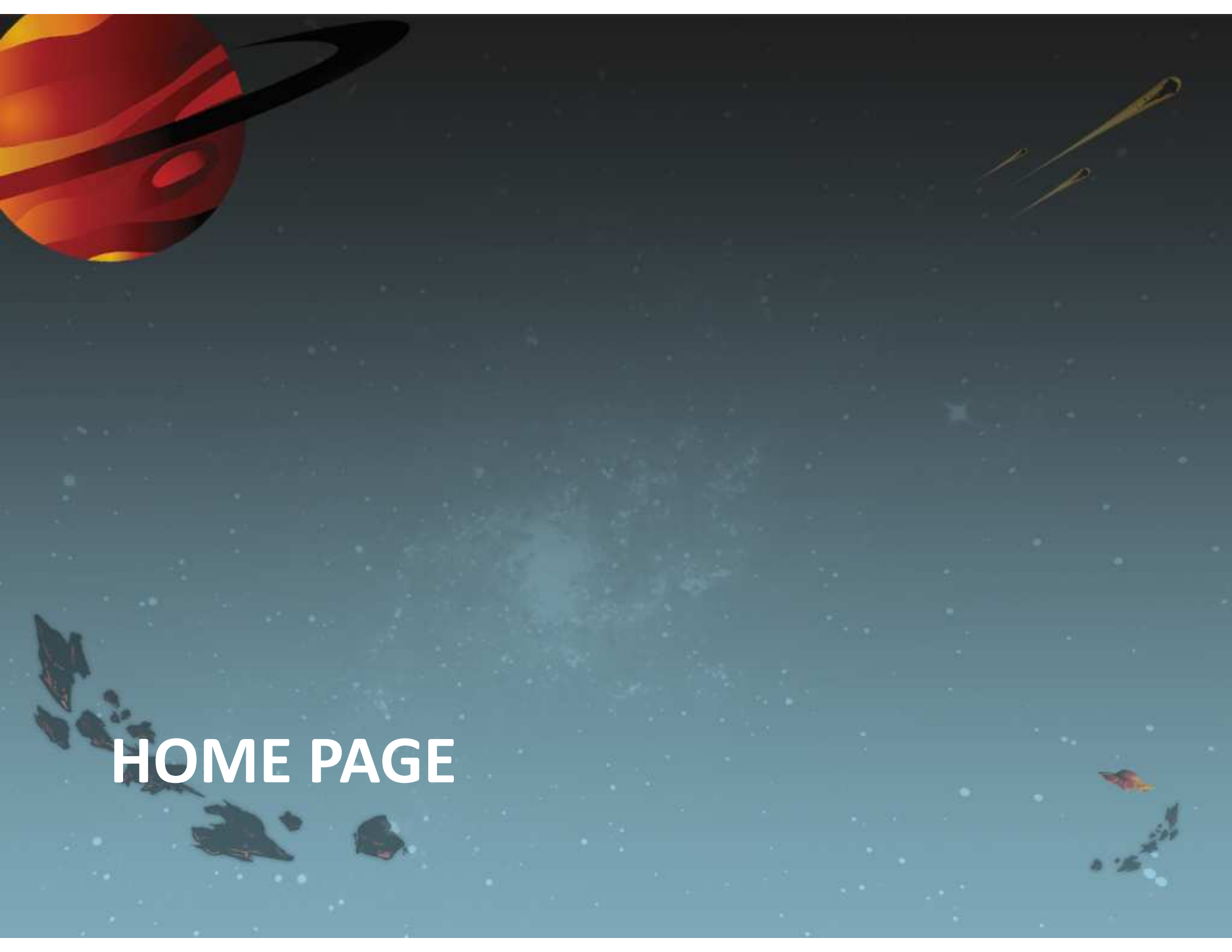

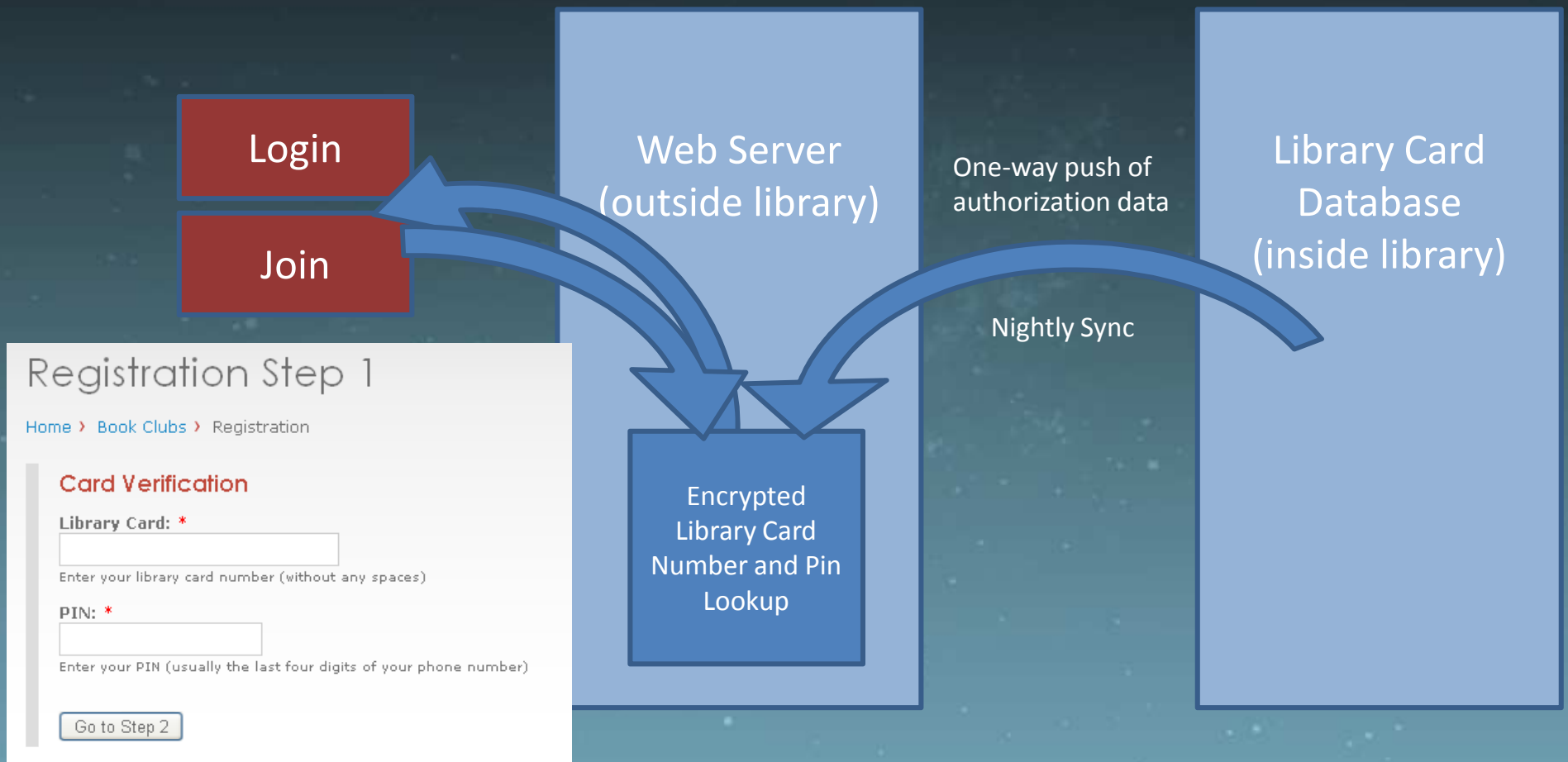
SECURITY AND SAFETY

Security and Safety Fundamentals

- Restricted to children by use of card authentication (limited to juvenile borrower types)
- Do not provide children's names or pictures on the site
- Do not provide a link between online persona and library cards anywhere on the site or in the database
- Easy ways to report inappropriate content
- Language filter that will remove bad words
- Moderation
- Security Module

How it Works

Users can be authenticated but additional information about the user can not be looked up.

MODERATION

Moderation

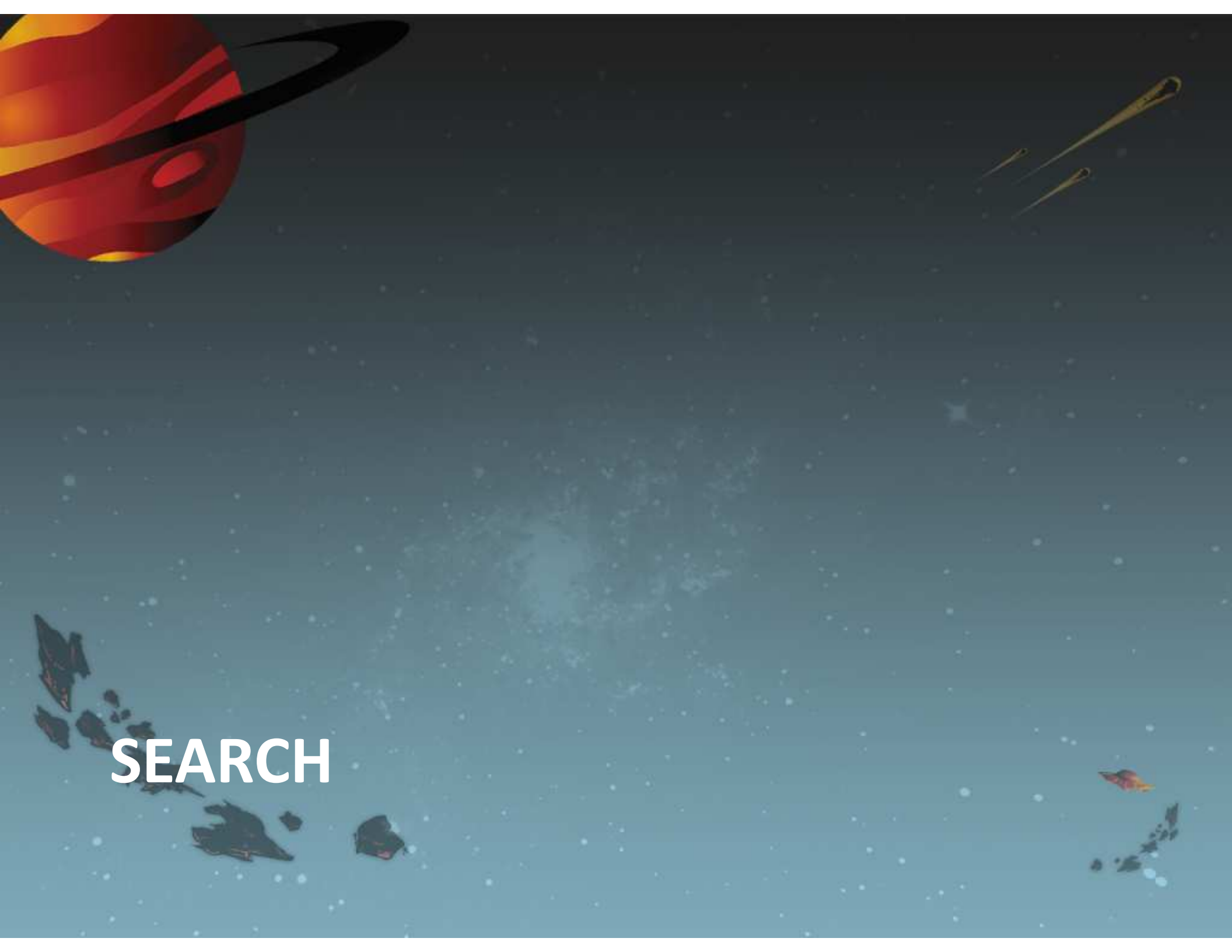
- All content moderated by library staff
- Shared responsibility amongst 4 district branches, which rotates quarterly
- Policy development on abusive posts & remedies for mitigation
- Takes about one hour/week
- Only inappropriate posts blocked from inclusion
 - No correction of spelling mistakes/grammatical errors

Types of Inappropriate Content

- Sexual innuendo
- Foul Language (not blocked by word filter)
- Derogatory comments about another person or posting
- Racist/sexist language
- Overtly aggressive language
- Personally identifiable information
- Content of a commercial nature
- Any form of coding, jumbles of letters
- Pig Latin, backward typing
- Junk Mail

Reporting Abuse

- Report Abuse button used to highlight inappropriate content
 - Policies developed how to deal with users posting inappropriate content/comments
 - Contact parent and ensure card is not lost
 - If lost, then expire card and issue new card to borrower
 - If not lost, detail concerns with parents and consider removal from club
- Not currently required, due to moderation

- Faceted browsing lets kids or parents find the subject, time or venue that is most appropriate
- Updated daily

Analytics and Observations

- 850 registered users
- 300 users have posted at least one item
- 2000 items posted
- 3 users posted over 100 items
- 10% users account for over 50% of the content
- Users would logon for a few days in a row, and then check back once a twice a few months later

Initial Response

- Site launched June 2007 for Summer Reading Club
- Kids loved interactive nature of the site – they loved to post and comment
- Site was short listed for a Webby Award

The Award

- Official Honoree in the Youth Category for the 12th Annual Webby Awards
- *Webby Honorees, Nominees and Winners truly represent the best of the web. They are but a small percentage of the total entries chosen by members of the International Academy of Digital Arts & Sciences.*



Usability Testing - 2008

- Library brand recognition did not exist – didn't relate to BOPL
- Older kids didn't like the site graphics in the bookclub
- Staging Issues: Web Safety Module appears after creation of usernames
- Placement of buttons. Had to move the Join Book Club as registered users hit this instead of login button that was below the fold
- Usability/Navigational Issues

2009 – Redesign the Site

- Site usage was dropping
- Some library staff weren't actively promoting it due to older kids' reactions to graphics
- Reiterated the concept was good & needed to better integrate into library book club programs
- Involved library children's staff with design and sought direct feedback from kids on mock-ups

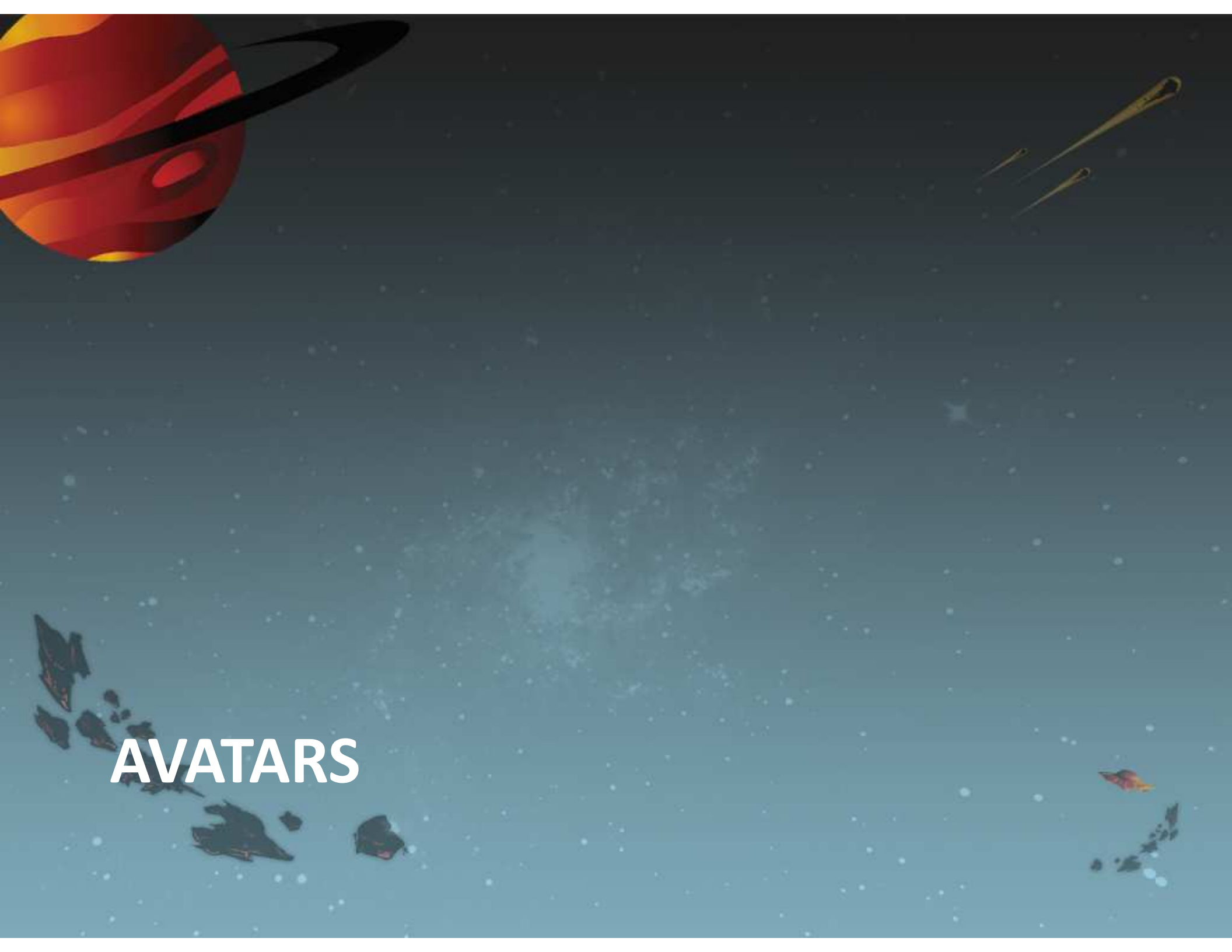

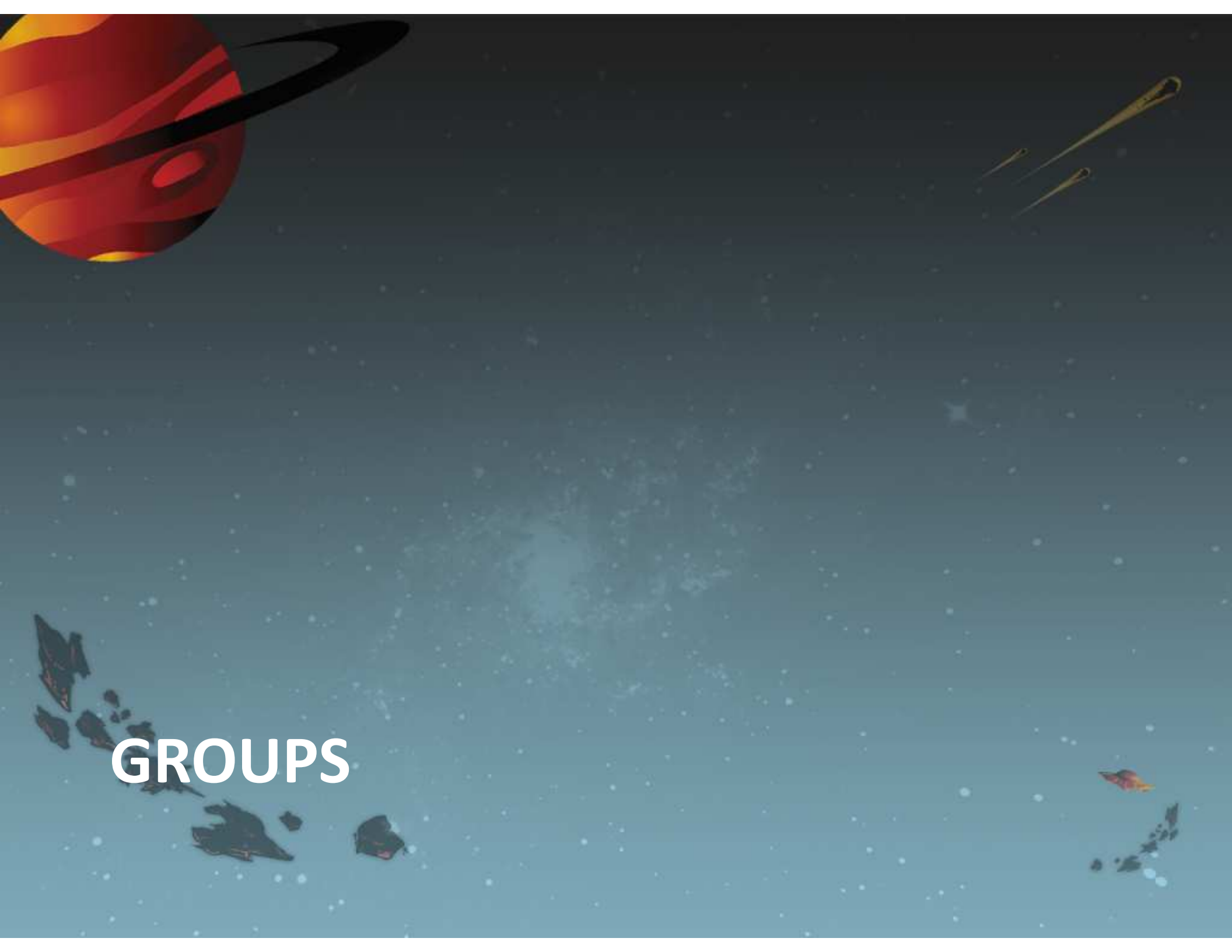

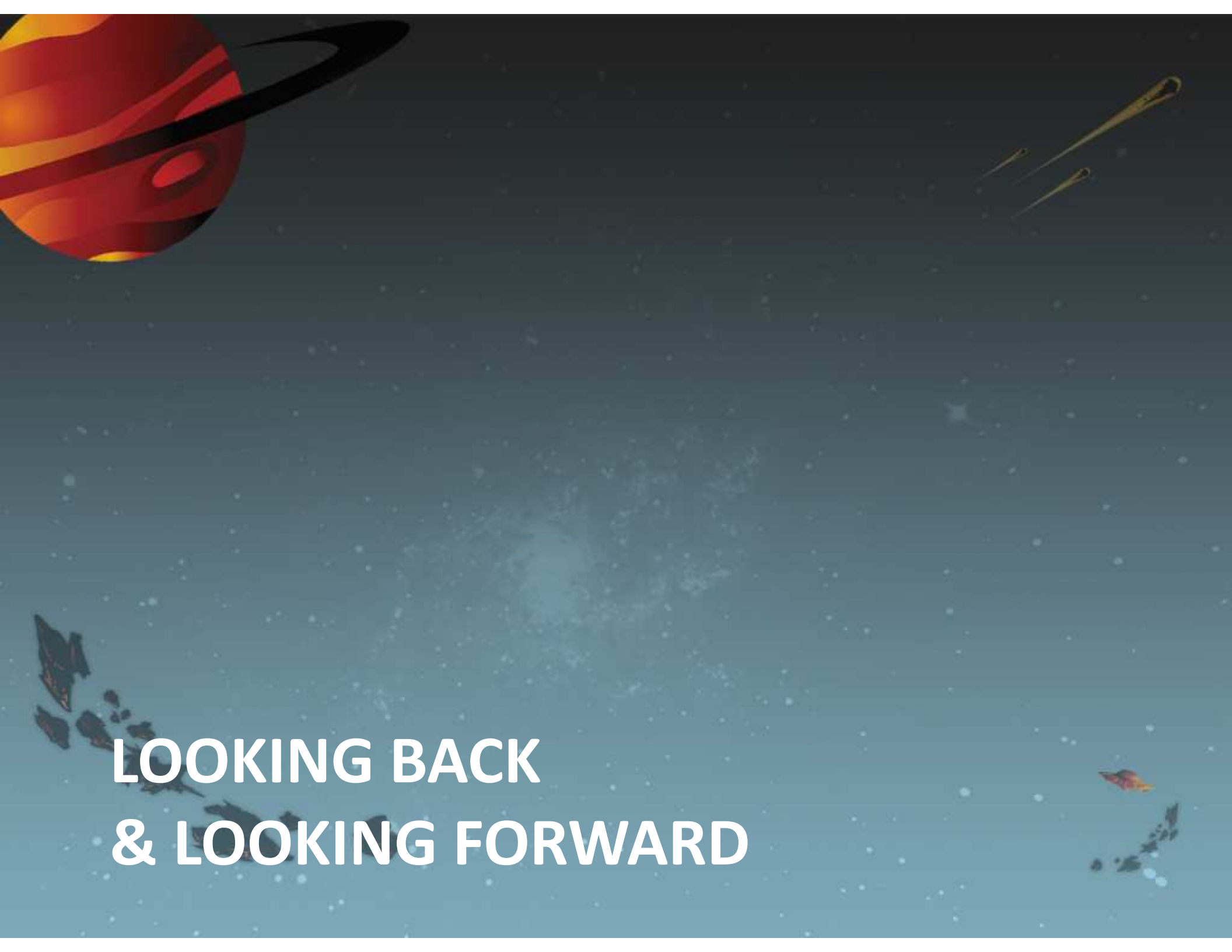

LOOKING BACK & LOOKING FORWARD

Lessons Learned

- Actively engage users in design process
- Tie web development to library programs/initiatives to keep content generation cycle active
- Use this as your children's communication mechanism
- Keep content fresh – even though preschool kids love the repetition their parents may not!

Next Steps

- Actively launch book club integration at OPL
- Heavily promote new look & feel
- Develop a new integrated games area for preschool site to allow them to choose between developed content
- Investigate further integration with BiblioCommons catalogue
- Work with partners to keep content fresh
 - Algonquin College pilot project
