Community buy in and Peer Reviews

- The premise is Peer to Peer based sharing, which applies to both goods and services.

- User Experience




Peer to Peer sharing makes people nicer

- When RelayRides, installed a device in renters' cars that allowed them to unlock it without meeting up to hand over the keys.
- Satisfaction went down nearly 40% and complains shot up fivefold.
- When they met in person, renters kept their car cleaner and returned them on time more often.



Items with high idling capacity

- The life time use of a power drill on average is 13 minutes (diynetwork).
- Books, DVDs and audiobooks all have high idling capacity. From an economic standpoint it makes more sense to borrow that to own.








- There is no single

- During the first two weeks equipment was offered to existing card holders only. Card holders were able to sign materials out for nonmembers. Suddenly the library had street cred and we had Brand Ambassadors



- Evaluate and Monitor

- Large increase in YA usage and participation.
- The first year we went through multiple sets of equipment.



- Keep Growing and looking for patterns.
- Break down a barrier to service.
- Our Young Adults were very surprised that the library cared about what they wanted. Now our Youth feel comfortable suggesting new games and a preference in equipment.
- The Recreation Library will expand to serve our seniors with urban walking poles and other equipment geared to the senior's population.
