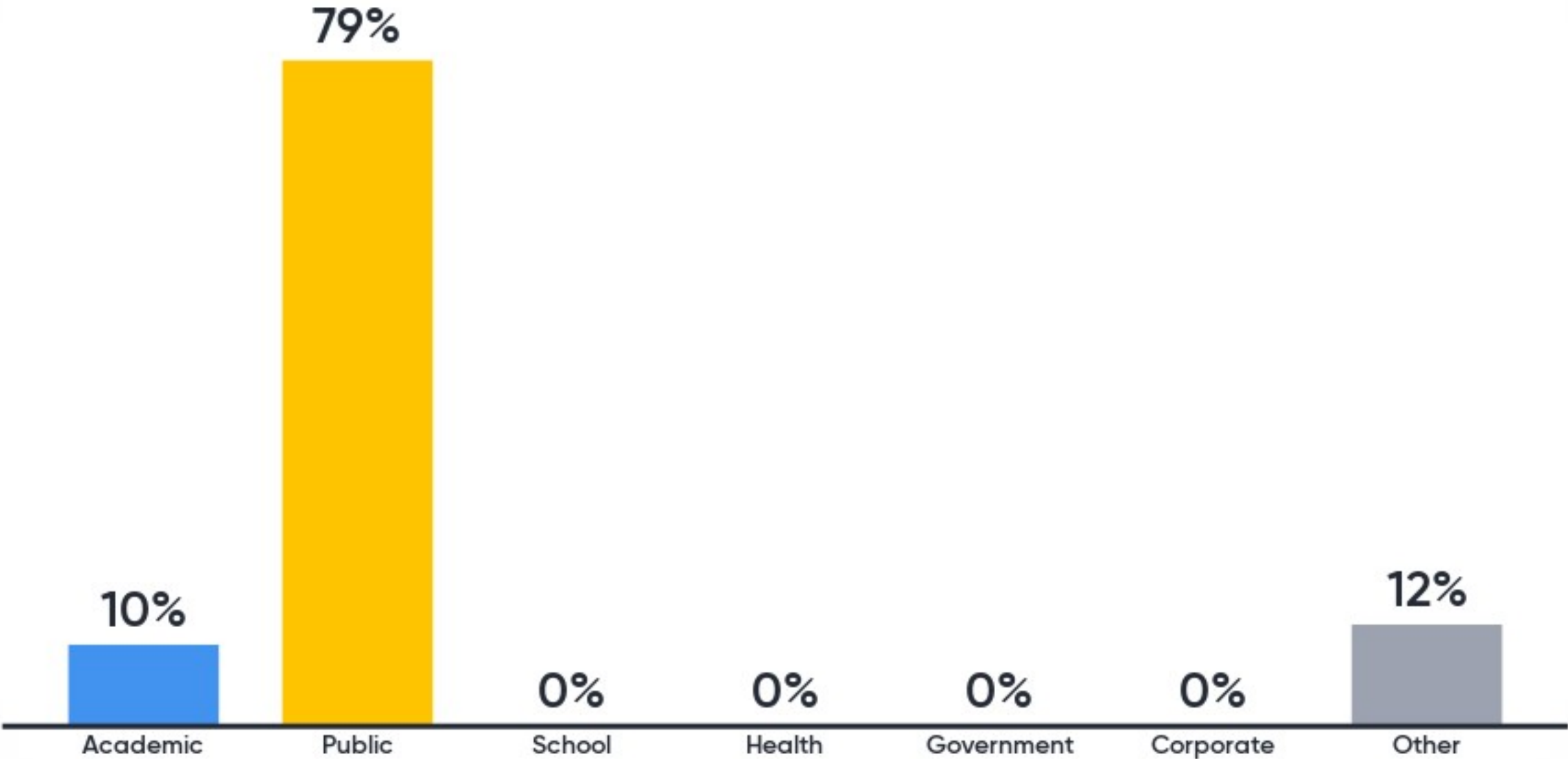

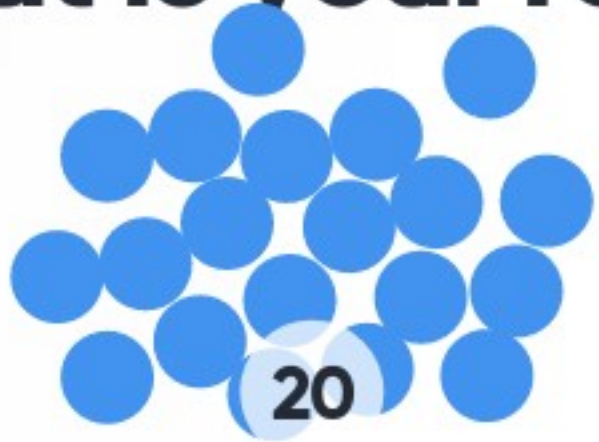

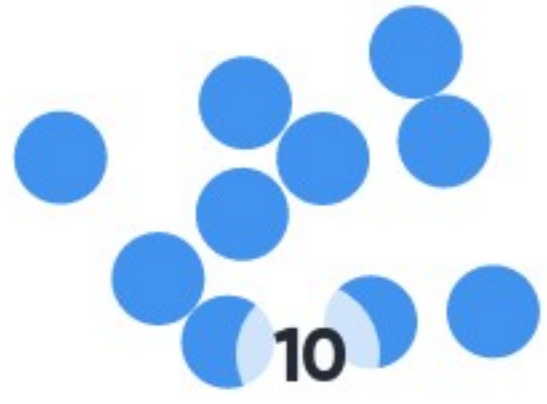
What type of library do you work in?

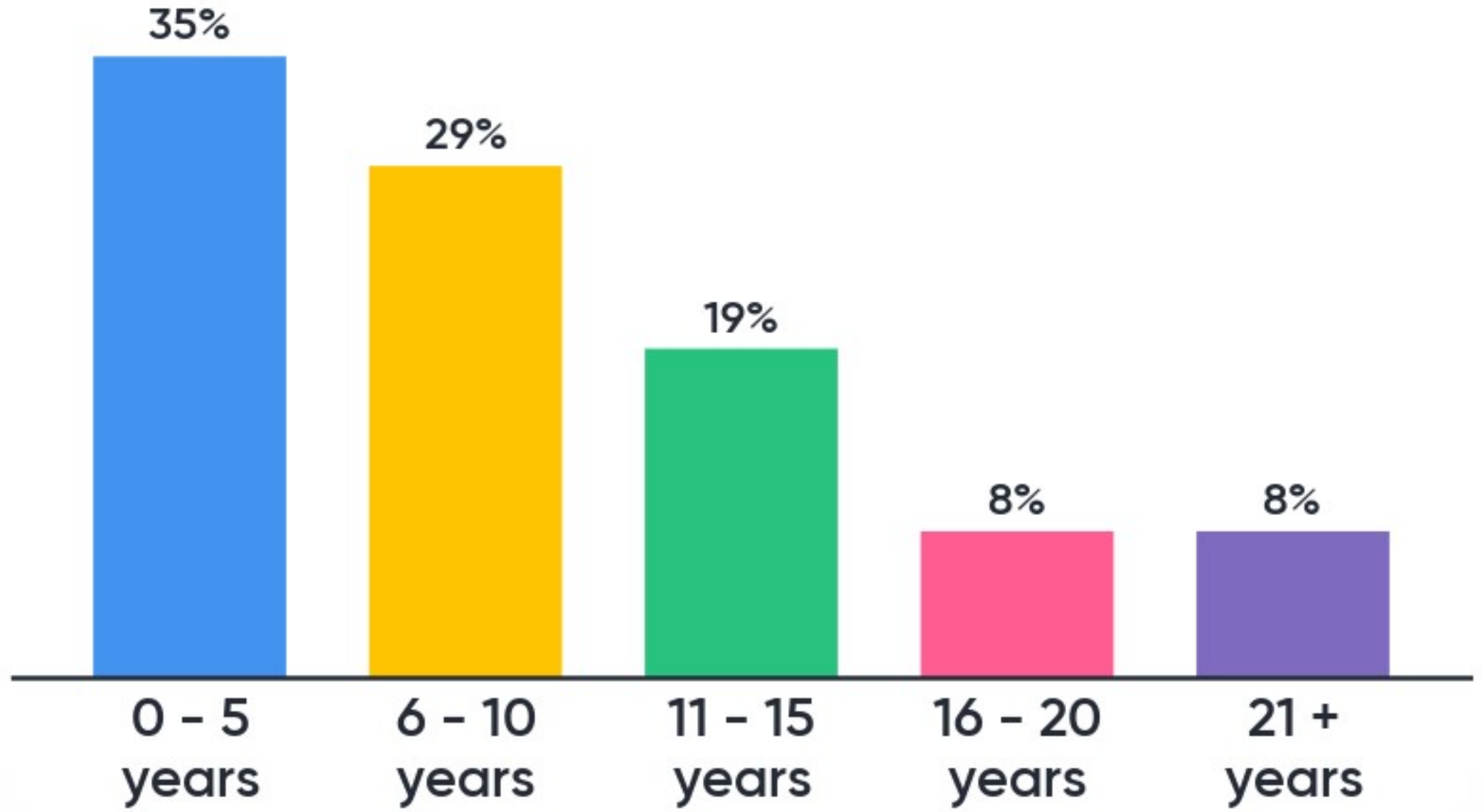

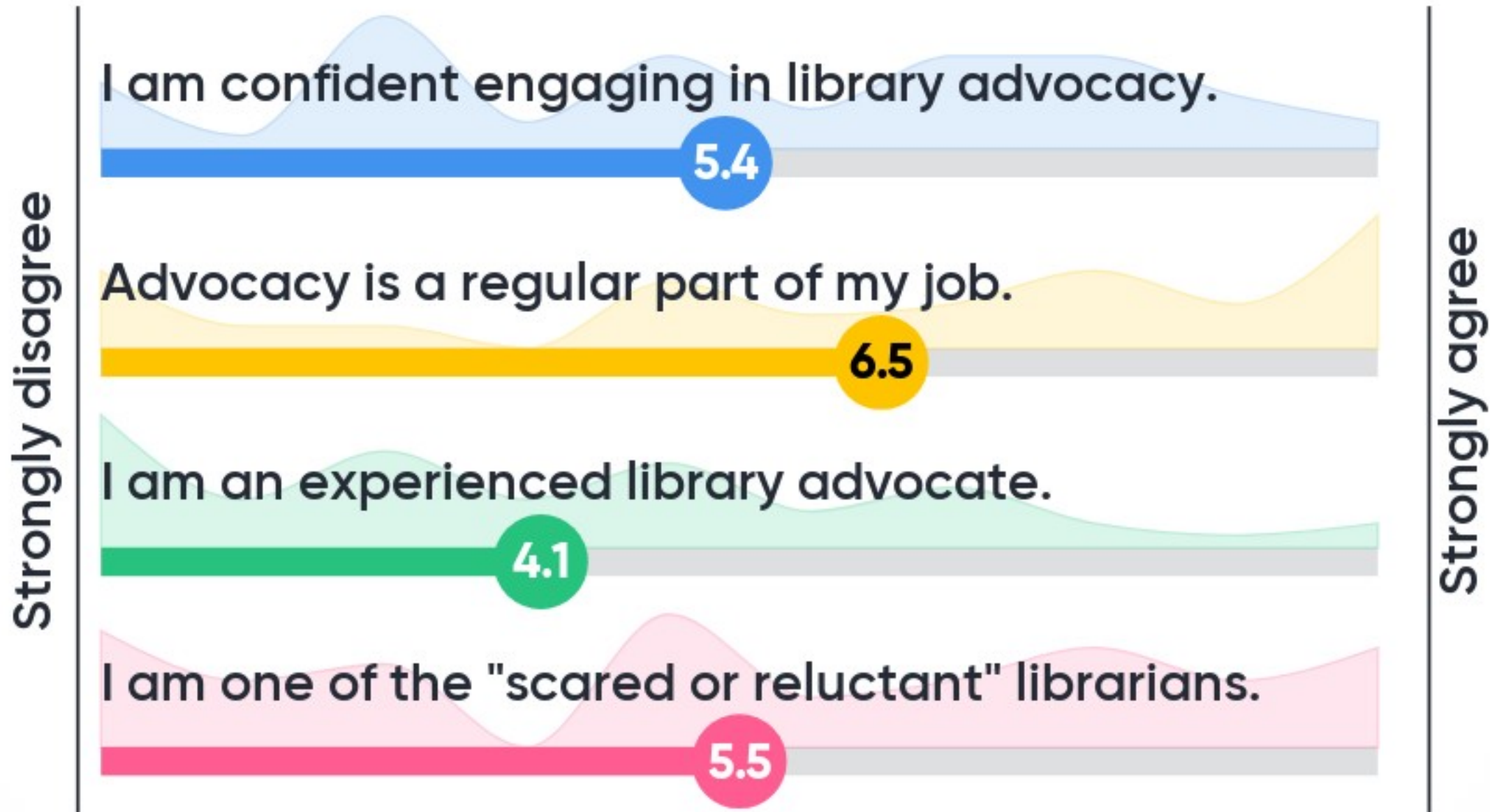
