WHY THIS TOPIC?

WHY THESE GROUPS?

- Individual interests in each group based on previous work and life experiences
- Belief that there are fundamental differences between these specific groups that may cause further marginalization - and impact access to healthcare information

Which factors most significantly impact a senior's access to the Internet and other digital technologies when searching for health care information?


Do factors such as ethnicity, cultural beliefs, and geographic location impact this?

What factors most significantly impact the rates of digital literacy and adoption or uptake amongst seniors when looking for health care information?


Do factors such as ethnicity, cultural beliefs, and geographic location impact this?

LIMITATIONS


SAMPLE SIZE Sample size less than anticipated Affects validity of some conclusions






FINDINGS

- Many seniors do not search for health information online
- Cost, connectivity and language are barriers
- Too much / too little trust in online information
- Gender and emotional labour




- Consumer health information

- Curated collection open access




- · Improved research skills
